L.	Minutes of the Previous Meeting	
	The minutes of the previous meeting held on 14 Oct 19 were agreed and signed. Due to

2.	Matters Arising	
	7. Following the suggestion of planting an orchard on Well Hill the Parish Council	
	arranged for tree expert, Dominic Driver to visit. Further progress could not be made	
	following local objections.	
8.	Annual Accounts for y/e 31 March 2020, 2021 and 2022	
	a. RG presented the accounts which showed a surplus for years 2020 and 2021 of £164	
	and £666 but a deficit for 2022 of $\pm 334$ .	
	b. The bonfire and fireworks took place each year (being an outdoor event) except in	
	Nov 2020 but the seniors' lunch was not permitted.	
	c. In 2021 we received some fireworks contributions and although these were used the	
	next year they contributed to the unusual surplus; we also received a 'Covid' support	
	grant from the Parish Council funded by Stroud District Council which was mostly	
	used to make improvements to the website.	
	d. In 2022 we made a grant for 'cube' seating at Well Hill, which explains the deficit.	
	e. The trustees are always open to suggestions to help fund new events.	
	f. The trust's assets totalled £16,699 at 31.03.22 (£13,705 at 31.03.19).
